# INTRODUCTION

The move aims to create accurate parameters in assessing the impact of CSR activities by shifting the focus from expenditure alone to impact assessment, and improve the quality of CSR projects while enhancing accountability and transparency.

Hence, to achieve impact on ground, enhance accountability and transparency, PMS needs to be strengthened; FICCI Aditya Birla CSR Centre for Excellence is organising a virtual training on Project Management Lifecycle for Developmental Projects to equip participants with fundamental tools and techniques for designing developmental projects that shall create impact on ground.
